**I. Call to Order** - The meeting was called to order by Vice President Bob Covington at 7:00p.m.

**IV. Old Business**

**Friends of the NRA Banquet** – Two members paid for seats at our table, but were unable to attend.

**Free Public Shoot** – The free public shoot day will be March 26<sup>th</sup> from 10:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m. We have 8 RSOs lined up. L. Keator is designing a sign-up sheet that will allow multiple participants to use instead of each person having an individual page. There will be an item in the Pueblo Chieftain in the local briefs section. We do not plan on doing any other advertising outside our web page.

**Voting Rights for Primary Member/Membership** – Tabled.

**Building and Safety Committee** – Filters are being changed more often due to the increase in shooters. HazMat will pick up a load on March 15<sup>th</sup>. The backstop was checked the last time the filters were changed and no damage was found. A case of new lights has been received. We had to replace two timer switches in the last few months. They are approximately \$22 each at Lowe's. It was suggested from the gallery to having lighting at 17' in the firing range. Les will check on the possibility of installing lights closer than 17' as it would mean a large electric wiring issue.

**Jr. Marksman** – There are 7 weeks left. There will be no classes during the week of spring break.

**Membership** – Numbers for current report will be delayed.

**Public Information** – No new developments.

**Education Committee** – No new developments.

**IRC** – Board reviewed the IRC recommendation and agreed to close Incident #17.

**RSO** - At times, a third RSO has been needed for part of a public night due to the high volume. Two RSOs have been suspended due to not turning membership paper work.

**Pistoleras** – The current group of Pistoleras has requested that the instructors cover maintenance and provide concealed carry information. The instructors will schedule times to present this information.

**Pistol League** – There are 23 shooters including 6 women. The Spring League has increased due to change in cost.

**Standard Operating Procedures** – Section 4, G of the Firing Range SOP was revised and submitted to the board. It was M/S by L. Keator/B. Covington to approve the revision. Motion carried. The Instructors Guidelines and Agreement, Other Guidelines, #1, 3, and 6 were discussed and will go to the SOP Committee.

V. **New Business** – Discussion was held regarding the need for a lockable storage container for the office. It was decided to purchase a hasp and lock for an existing cabinet.
