- I. Call to Order** - The meeting was called to order by President Terry Curtis at 6:55p.m.

Board members absent – Paula Mitchell
- II. Minutes** - It was M/S by R. Wiley/C. Wingfield to approve the minutes of the April 11, 2016 meeting. Motion carried.
- III. Financial Statements** – Peggy Walker presented the financial report. It was M/S by L. Keator/R. Wiley to approve. Motion carried.

- New Target Systems** – B. Covington will contact the company for more complete picture of the costs.
- Gutters** – Gutters were installed.
- Large Rules Sign** – T. Curtis has not provided a mock-up to be approved yet.
- By-Laws** - Voting rights of members and volunteer recognition program will be worked by T. Curtis and P. Walker to be presented at future meeting.
- Building and Safety Committee** – Electrician found controls for air handling system were adjusted causing irregular function. Controls will be relocated to a lockable box to secure access. Air conditioners have been readied for summer use. Heat has been turned off. South end motors were oscillating due to wiring and a bad motor. Motor to be replaced. Seam on roof is causing the leak and will be looked into. Filters have been ordered. Going to maintain 2 sets of filters on hand at all times. Additional research is ongoing regarding the additional lighting in each shooting lane. The spring cleanup had 6 volunteers to help.
- Jr. Marksman** – Finished until August 30. Did purchase new locker. Mats have been de-leaded.
- Membership** – Current membership stands at 653. New membership forms were updated to reflect the new NRA membership pricing. Current forms will be used until gone, then new forms will be printed.
- Free Gun Safety Class** – There were 27 attendees in the month April.
- Public Information** – Web site was updated to reflect a clearer explanation of fees.
- Education Committee** – No new developments.
- IRC** – 2 letters were sent to the related parties for incident 18 and 19 and they are considered closed.
- RSO** – Meeting expected in May. More RSO are needed to cover all of the programs at the range in

addition to the required coverage for public night.

Pistoleras – The current session is ending May 23rd. New session to begin mid-September and may contain an advanced group in addition to the new participants. The groups will still be limited to 10 participants.

Pistol League – Efforts will be taken to coordinate with the zoo and other city park events to avoid parking issues.

Standard Operating Procedures – Facility use discuss regarding range compensation yielded a decision M/S by L. Keator/B. Covington to require the upcoming gun law seminar to reimburse the range using the same rate structure as instructor's use; \$10 per non-member attendee and \$2 per member attendee. Motion carried. The event sponsor will be notified.
