  - II. **Minutes** – April 10<sup>th</sup>, 2017 board meeting minutes were presented by Rick Quinn. A motion to accept the minutes as presented was made by Nick M., 2<sup>nd</sup> by Tom B. Motion carried.
  - III. **Financial Report** – April 2017 financial report was presented by Peggy Walker. Highlighted sections included brass sales made to individuals, RSO supplies purchased and pistol league final night costs. Motion to accept the financial statement was made by Bob C., 2<sup>nd</sup> by Bill M. Motion carried.
  - IV. **Old Business:**
    - a. Large rules sign update – Terry C. presented a sample new range rules sign and a motion to go ahead with the project as presented was made by Peggy W., 2<sup>nd</sup> by Bill M. Motion carried.
    - b. Ammo sales update – Program moving forward for public night sales. So far, there are six volunteers who have signed up to sell ammo. A safe was donated to house the ammo. A discussion occurred on obtaining more ammo. Program starting up Tuesday, May 9, 2017. A motion was made to have a \$70 starting bank for the ammo sales by Bill M., 2<sup>nd</sup> by Bob C. Motion carried.

    - d. Education – April 15<sup>th</sup> free shoot had 30 persons total.
    - e. Incident Review – #26, Letter to be sent to POI and no further action needed – BOD concurs; #27, POI contacted and no further action recommended – BOD concurs; #28 POI contacted – no further action recommended - BOD concurs. New incident #29 there is no resolution or recommendation. New incident #30 there is no resolution or recommendation.
    - f. Membership report – 680 current members. May new member night there were 13 new members. 96 new memberships for 2017.
    - g. Public Information
