- I. **Call to Order:** The meeting was called to order by President Terry Curtis at 7:01 p.m. Board members present: Bob Covington, Terry Curtis, Rick Quinn, Nick Mangini, Tom Bailey, Chuck Wingfield, Peggy Walker and Bill Morris.
- II. **Board Member Candidates:** Candidates Christian Nordstrom, Vic Gustafson, Miguel Elias and Jay Balestrieri presented themselves to the BOD for consideration.
- III. **Instructor Candidates:** Candidate Antonio Serna presented himself to the BOD for consideration.
- IV. **Minutes:** November 13, 2017 board meeting minutes presented by Rick Q. A motion to accept the minutes as presented made by Tom B., 2nd by Nick M. Motion carried.
- V. **Financial Report:** November 2017 financial report was presented by Peggy W. Highlighted sections included ammo sales, guest fees at \$512 was lower and instructor fees have been lower. The liability insurance and range supplies costs created a negative balance of \$-9,566 for November's PnL. A comparison of the income and expenses for 2017 through Dec.10 was presented. Motion to accept the financial statement was made by Chuck W., 2nd by Bob C. Motion carried.
- VI. **Old Business:**
 - a. Ceiling fan purchase selection remains in progress.
 - b. Motion to raise minor member shooting fee to \$1 effective Jan. 1 made by Bob C., 2nd by Nick M. Motion carried.
 - c. Annual banquet review: Agenda, donation needs, volunteers for door greeter and other program notes all reviewed and provided on a spreadsheet for the 2018 annual banquet. A motion was made by Nick M. to have a silent auction to sell an un-needed Jr. Marksman rifle, 2nd by Bill M. Motion carried.
- VII. **Committees:**
 - a. Building and Safety presented by Nick M. Old filters were removed by the recycler. Brass buckets emptied. Lane 8 red curtain was replaced. December 6th the gas pressure was checked by the gas company and resulted in R Buck Heating to be employed to check the gas pressure. Lower filters changed on both sides of the range. Entry badges were ordered.
 - b. By-Laws: Nothing to report.
 - c. SOPs: Nothing to report
 - d. Education: US Law Shield gunshot wound presentation \$60 for non-members, \$40 for members discussed, but information to be provided to RSOs for individual consideration. A single PMS Representative to attend may be an option.
 - e. Incident Review: Nothing new to report.
 - f. Membership: 741 current memberships. December new member night there were 15 new members, 156 for the year.

- b.** RSOs: RSO meeting held December 2. Three new RSOs – Joe Pullaro, Kim & Walter Guerrero. 29 current RSOs.

- d.** Pistoleras: First half of the session completed, on track.
- e.** Pistol League: Completed, a procedural meeting was held Nov. 15th. A pre-shoot will be scheduled before the next league. Start date TBD. A new pin design presented at a cost of \$503 to be paid for by program monies – no club funds necessary.
- f.** Jr. Marksman: Last week, 25 kids total. Next session to begin January 30th.

- a.** Groupon contacted the range but their pitch or model did not seem reasonable for PMS purposes.
- b.** Chuck Wingfield was presented a plaque recognizing his service on the BOD.
