- A. Building and Safety – 12/16/18 changed upper and lower filters on the North side, lower filters on the South side. 12/18/18 cleaned 18 buckets of lead from the North side. 1/8/19 changed upper and lower filters on the South side. 1/27/19 changed lower filters on the North side. 2/3/19 cleaned 19 buckets of lead from the South side. 2/8/19 North side low voltage breaker tripping – found bare wire on lane ten limit switch 2/10/19 cleaned lead from North side. Made a temporary repair to lane ten wiring.
