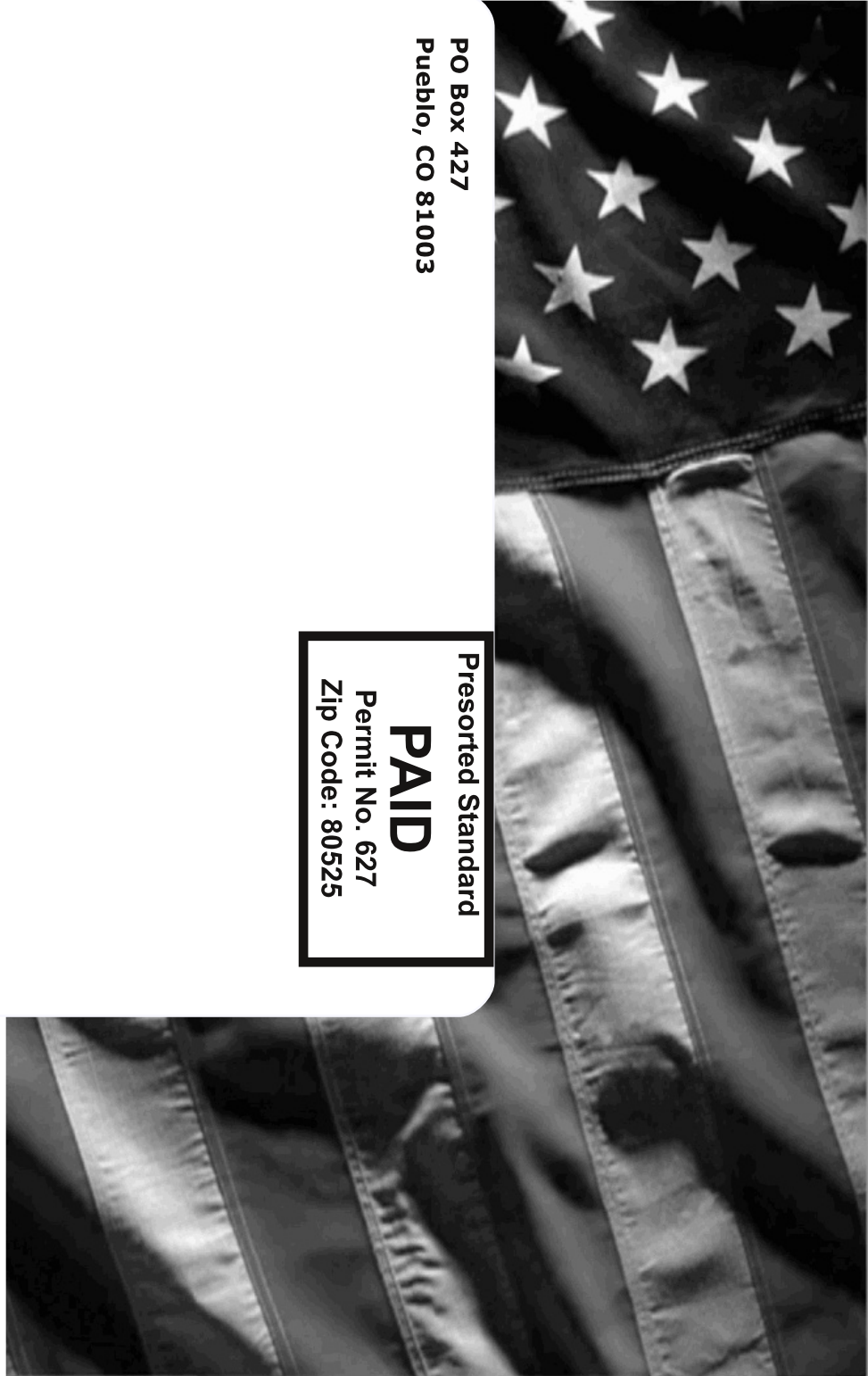

### Meet your Treasurer...

Hi. I am Peggy Walker and I serve as the board treasurer for our organization. I became a board member in March to assist in the continuity of the mission of this organization with a hope of helping to provide a well-organized club with a clear vision and methods for success. Last year as the By-Laws committee chairperson, the By-Laws committee was successful in a complete comprehensive rewrite of the by-laws.

As a child, my father encouraged my 'tomboy' ways by presenting me with a .22 rifle for my 8th birthday. So, I became familiar with guns from an early age, hunting squirrels and other small game with my dad. But, my real love was horses and I rode for many years in the Westernaires, a youth riding group out of Lakewood, Colorado that traveled throughout the United States. Now, over the course of the last two years, my husband has re-introduced me to the familiar feel of steel and lead.

I worked at Rocky Flats, a nuclear weapons plant, for the chief legal counsel. After a move to Grand Junction, I coordinated a school ski program before moving to Pueblo. I tutored vocational students for District 60 and 70 before moving to Arizona where I worked for the City of Lake Havasu.

After my return to Pueblo (a town I love), I was the executive assistant for the director of the Health Department. I became involved in the first start-up program of the SANE/SART rape crisis team. I served as a SART and also became a CASA volunteer for a short time. I also represented the Health Department at state suicide prevention committee meetings. After moving to Monument, I worked for the City Manager and Deputy City Manager of Colorado Springs. Since my return to Pueblo, I now work as the office manager for SyCare, a behavioral health organization.

I have served on various boards including Runyon Field Baseball, the Pueblo Child Advocacy, and the Juvenile Community Corrections Review Board for Pueblo County. Until recently, I served on the Adult Community Corrections Review Board.

### My how times have changed....



Colorado Concealed Handgun Permits are strange and wonderful things. Basically we live in a lawless state, but this can be good and bad for anyone who possesses concealed handgun permit.

People who took a Colorado Concealed Handgun Permit Class within the last 10 years are no longer obliged to take classes to renew their permit under the law. Military recently discharged from service are not required to take any classes to obtain a carry permit.

The issues, techniques, and regulations for handgun safety are changing all the time. Responsible gun handlers should seek continual education to keep themselves safe and to know all the current developments and rules. A recent survey showed that 8 out of 10 individuals with carry permits for the last 5 years don't really understand the laws and regulations in Colorado.
