# Pueblo Municipal Shooters, Inc. <br> Standard Operating Procedures <br> Free Gun Safety Class \#28 

## PURPOSE:

The mandatory requirement of the FGSC for new members began January 1, 2014. The purpose of the Free Gun Safety Class (FGSC) is to increase the student's knowledge regarding gun safety and comprehension of the Pueblo Municipal Shooters, Inc. (PMS) range specific safety guidelines, and to improve overall safety and enjoyment of the range for members and the public.

## OBJECTIVES:

To provide education for all new members, prospective members, and the public to make the range a safer place to shoot by providing information to:

1. Understand general gun safety guidelines and rules.
2. Learn the range specific guidelines for PMS.

## PROCEDURES:

1. All new members of the PMS range who obtain an entry badge are required to attend the training within 60 days of joining the range unless extraordinary circumstances (approved by the chairperson) preclude doing so. Normally, failure to attend a scheduled class within 60 days will result in the member's access being suspended until the training is completed. Prospective new members who attended the FGSC prior to joining the range will not be required to attend a second time.
2. Sign-ups for the FGSC will be accomplished on the www.puebloshooters.org website. If an interested person does not have access to the internet, they may contact the FGSC Chairperson directly to signup.
3. The FGSC will be made available at least once monthly (currently on the $3^{\text {rd }}$ Monday of each month at 6 p.m.) with additional dates and times scheduled, as necessary.
4. The classes may be tailored to reflect the knowledge of the attendees, i.e., more experienced shooters may not require as much firearms mechanics, etc.
5. FGSC trainers should be current PMS RSOs or board-approved instructors.
6. The FGSC Chairperson shall oversee the training information provided to ensure PMS updated range rules and current safety procedures and policies are being taught.
